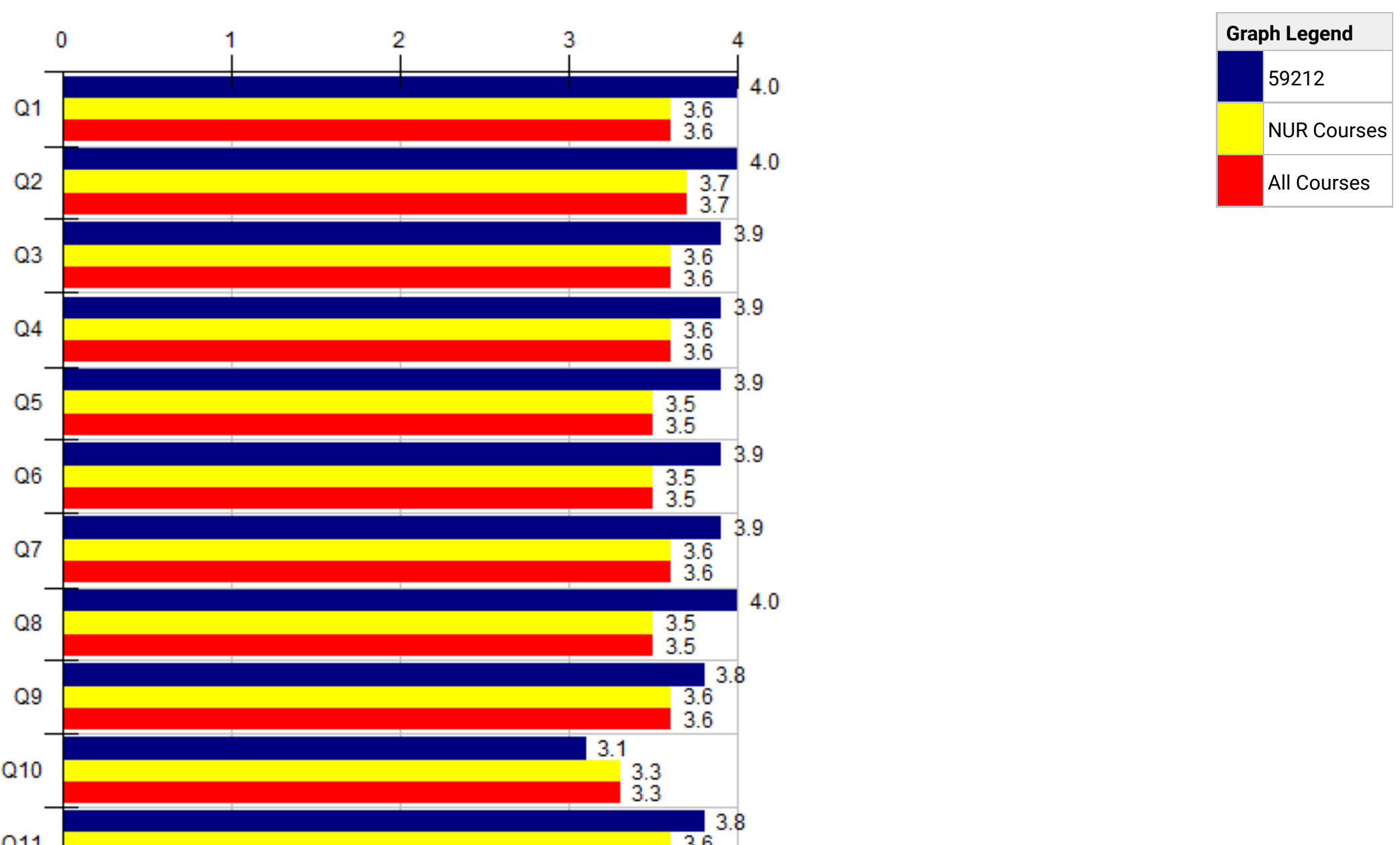

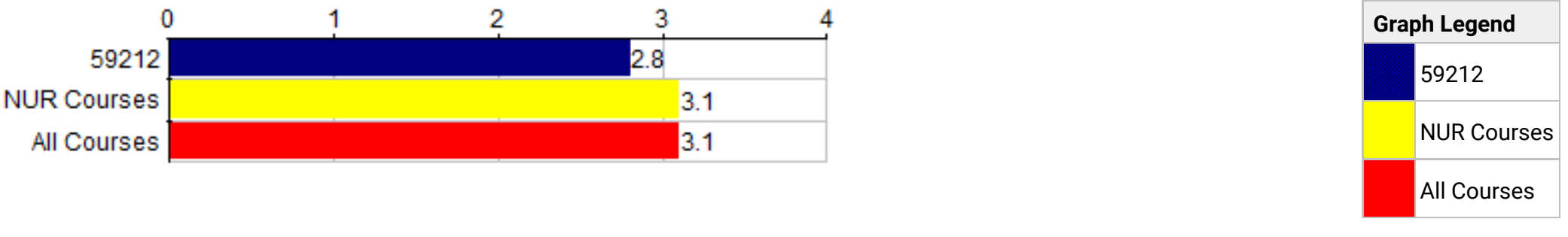
- This course was a process of self reflection for the student. It truly enhanced the learning experience.

- Critical thinking and the reflective process needs to be introduced or touched upon in every nursing course that is provided.

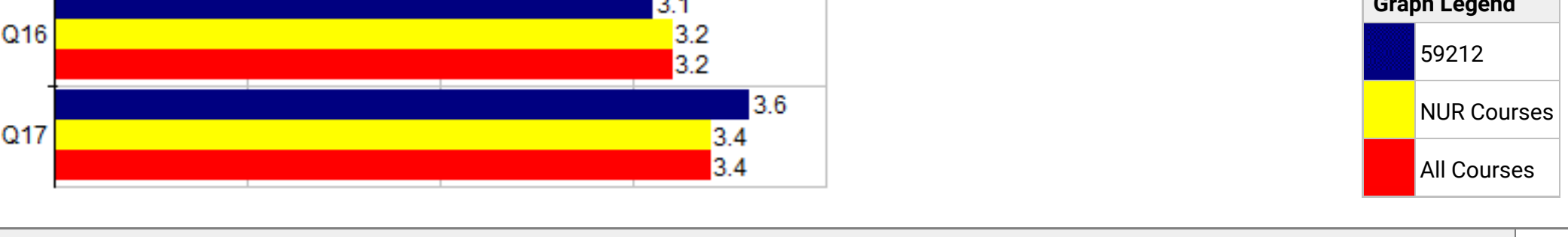

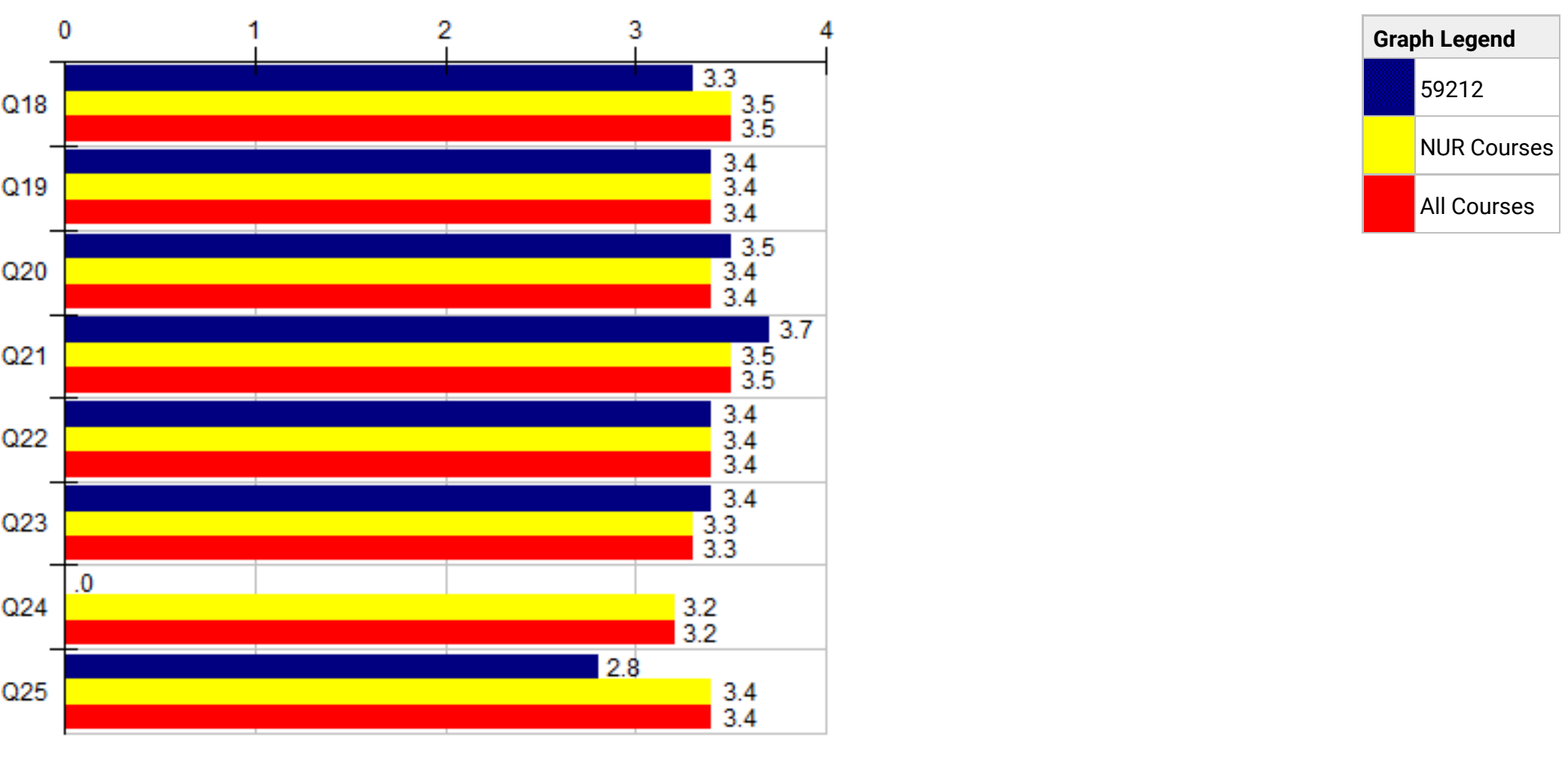

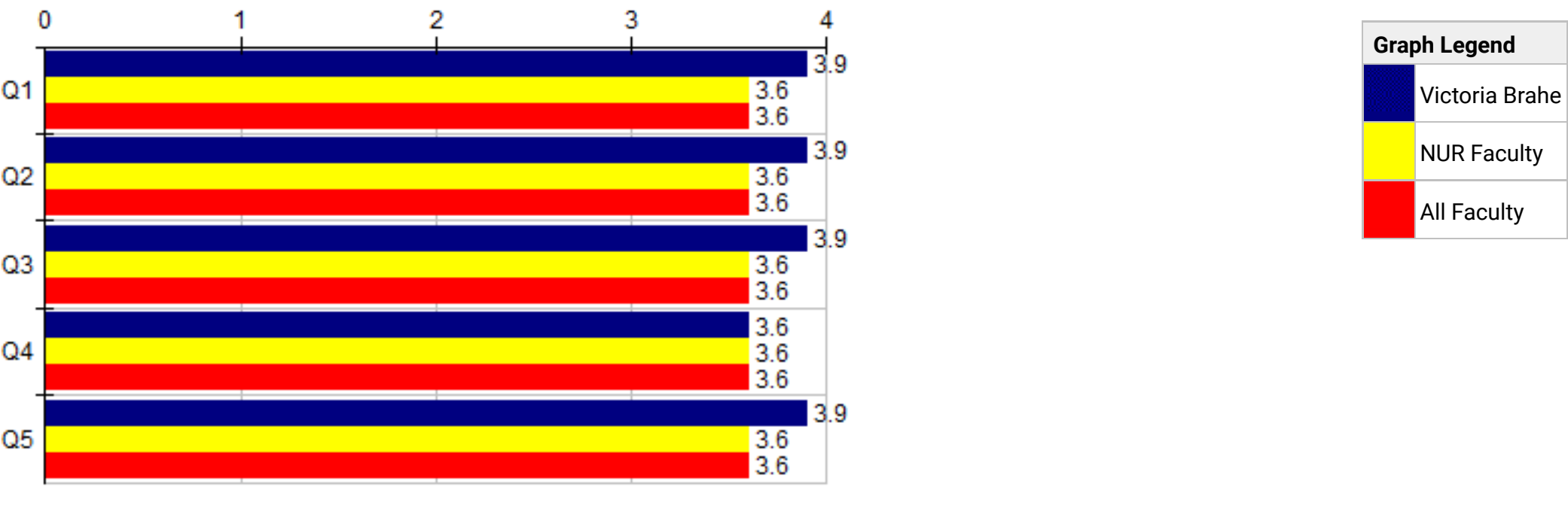
